Planning Team Volunteers

We are seeking 10-12 Planning Team Volunteers. As a volunteer, you'll commit to bi-weekly meetings from February through August, with an average monthly commitment of 5-6 hours, and increased involvement (10-30 hours) in August to help implement the Festival. Volunteers will also work independently within subcommittees on specific tasks, such as proposal review, partner communication, and event logistics. Subcommittees may vary, but typically align with Festival elements like Built Installations, Pop-Up Programming, Mainstage, and Mixers. - Reliable: Able to attend all meetings and meet time commitments.
- Collaborative: Willing to support team needs and foster a cooperative spirit.

- Passionate: Enthusiastic about design, urbanism, arts, public programming, or event management. You don't need to be a design professional—all skill sets are welcome!

Chair Role

Want to have an even larger impact on SDF '25? We are looking for **two Chairs** to manage and lead the Festival alongside the Planning Committee and staff.

Chairs will:

- Project manage the festival, coordinating the schedule, staffing, and budget with SDF staff.
- Mentor Planning Committee members, helping them lead their subgroups effectively.
- Actively promote the festival on personal and professional social media channels.
- Serve as ambassadors for SDF and the festival, building and maintaining relationships citywide.
- Organize bi-weekly meetings with the Planning Committee, documenting key points and decisions.
- Manage SDF's Google Drive to ensure activities and plans are organized and accessible.
